Creating a Tag Line that will assist in the efforts in positioning and reinforcing the school's unique identity.

Providing support for students including learning differences and social-emotional issues.

- Recruiting and supporting our caring, nurturing faculty and staff, as they are at the center of the Cassata student experience.
- Developing specialized programs to address the anticipated continued increase in the number of freshmen students.
- Expanding or renovating our campus facilities to accommodate more students, widen our course offerings, and continue to provide an environment conducive to learning and social interaction.
- Committing the necessary organization and resources to accomplish these goals.
- Exploring the possibility of an online high school program which would allow for quality high school education for more students.
- Providing support for students including learning differences and social-emotional/mental issues.

Committing to development expertise through an active process of database management, alumni engagement, and major gift programs.

Initiating a Feasibility Study to determine the potential for funding the most important capital needs.
